What is the future of CBC on EU's external borders?

- Cooperation shall continue!
- Change in the working context – jump into Interreg -context
- Same general policy objectives as in the Cohesion policy
- Changes to the procedures in the management of programme and projects

Interreg as a working context

- Works under DG Regio – now under DG NEAR
- Part of cohesion policy – regulations guiding the implementation
- In the same package as EU's internal border programmes
- “Interreg Neighbourhood CBC Programmes”
- Financing in EU context from two sources: Interreg and NDICI

Policy objectives

- Smarter Europe
- Greener Europe
- More connected Europe
- More social Europe
- Europe closer to citizens

+ Interreg specific objectives Better Interreg Governance and safer and more secure Europe

Schedules

- Regulatory frame still under negotiations
- Financing for Interreg is open as long as the multiannual financial frame for EU is open
- Expected that regulations and financing clear during the German presidency at the latest (second half of 2020)

Schedules for Programming

- Agreement on geography by the end of 2019
- As soon as the geography agreed, the programming to be launched
- Objective to be ready with programmes by the end of 2020
- Note: financing agreement
